


1. Once the installation is complete, you will now see a Cisco folder in the Start Menu, as shown below. Click on the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client to open the VPN app.



2. After clicking on the Cisco AnyConnect icon, you may get the following screen popping up on the lower right-hand side of the screen. Enter vpn.collegiseducation.com in the blank line and click on Connect.



3. The following screen will pop up. Put in your Rasmussen E-mail and click "Next."




